- 1) In the Abstract, the penultimate sentence “The associations were largely identical, with the exception of an increase in explained variance when predicting age from the VAS version of Excitement Seeking ($B_{10} = 125.1$, $\Delta R^2 = .025$).” should be changed to “The associations were largely identical, with the exception of an increase in explained variance when predicting age from the VAS version of Excitement Seeking ($B_{10} = 1318.95$, $\Delta R^2 = .025$).”
- 2) On page 4, Statistical analyses, at the end of the second paragraph, the sentence that reads “To avoid type I-error inflation due to multiple testing, the significance level was set to.” should be changed to “To avoid type I-error inflation due to multiple testing, the significance level was set to $p < .01$. ”
